REGISTRATION FEE SECURITY DEPOSIT TUITION FEES

There is a non-refundable registration fee of \$75.00 due at the time of registration. In addition, a two week NON-REFUNDABLE security deposit will be required. This deposit will be applied as payment of your child's LAST two weeks of school.

If our service is to be discontinued for any reason, 2 week's notice is required. Without the 2 week's notification, your security deposit will not be refunded.

Tuition is payable in advance, and is due every other Friday. A tuition statement will be put in your child's folder the week payment is due.

A \$25.00 late fee will be added to your account for every 5 days that your tuition is late. Late fees must be included with your next tuition payment.

If payment is not received within 10 days of the due date, your child will not be able to return to school without full payment.

Our business hours are 7:30-6:30, Monday-Friday.

If a check is returned, all bank charges will be the parent's responsibility.

Children attending school the whole year are entitled to one week vacation. (Does not apply to those off throughout the summer)

All Key-Scans must be returned on your child's last day of school. There is a \$25.00 fee for those not returned or lost.

Dear Parents,

The following is a guideline to prepare for your child's first day of school:

SUPPLIES

- EXTRA CLOTHING (weather appropriate) shirt, pants, socks, 2 pairs of underwear
- LUNCH BOX
- SMALL BLANKET & CRIB SHEET to be brought home on Fridays washed and returned
- SMOCK
- UNIVERSAL HEALTH FORM AND IMMUNIZATIONS

FOOD/LUNCH

- A morning and afternoon snack with juice will be provided. Additional snacks may be brought in daily. (Optional)
- Frozen lunches are not permitted. Lunches should not exceed 2 minutes in the microwave.

FOLDERS

All correspondence will be place in your child's folder located in the hallway. Folders should be checked DAILY for important information.

DAILY SHEETS

A daily sheet will be handed out daily. The sheets will supply you with information regarding your child's day. This will include: lunch, nap, and diaper changes.

TOYS

Please do not bring any toys to school. Children tend to be possessive over their own belongings causing conflict in the classroom. We will have a special day of "Show and Tell". Please refer to our monthly calendar for the dates

IMMUNIZATIONS

Students MUST be up to date with all of their immunizations. A copy of the updated immunizations MUST be submitted on his/her first day of school and when new vaccines are received.

FLU VACCINES

All students 6 months –5 years old MUST receive their FLU vaccine during FLU season (9/1-12/31).
