**REGISTRATION FEE
SECURITY DEPOSIT
TUITION FEES**

There is a non-refundable registration fee of \$75.00 due at the time of registration. In addition, a two week NON-REFUNDABLE security deposit will be required. This deposit will be applied as payment of your child's LAST two weeks of school.

If our service is to be discontinued for any reason, 2 week's notice is required. Without the 2 week's notification, your security deposit will not be refunded.

Tuition is payable in advance, and is due every other Friday. A tuition statement will be put in your child's folder the week payment is due.

A \$25.00 late fee will be added to your account for every 5 days that your tuition is late. Late fees must be included with your next tuition payment.

If payment is not received within 10 days of the due date, your child will not be able to return to school without full payment.

If a check is returned, all bank charges will be the parent's responsibility.

Our Business hours are 7:30-6:30, Monday-Friday.

Children attending school the whole year are entitled to one week vacation.
(Does not apply to those off throughout the summer)

All Key-scans must be returned on your child's last day of school. There is a \$25.00 fee for all those keys not returned or lost.

Dear Parents,

The following is a guideline to help prepare for your child's first day of school:

SUPPLIES

- EXTRA CLOTHING – 2 shirts, pants, socks, onesie, etc.
- LUNCH (Daily)
- SMALL BLANKET & CRIB SHEET – to be brought home on Fridays washed and returned
- DIAPERS (whole package)
- WIPES (whole package)
- BIBS
- BOTTLES/SIPPIE CUPS (to be brought home daily)
- SMOCK
- COPY OF UPDATED IMMUNIZATIONS

PLEASE REMEMBER TO LABEL ALL ITEMS

FOOD/LUNCH

- A morning and afternoon snack with juice will be provided. Additional snacks may be brought in daily.
- Frozen lunches are not permitted. Lunches should not exceed 2 minutes in the microwave

FOLDERS

All correspondence will be placed in your child's folder located in the hallway. Folders should be checked daily for important information.

DAILY SHEETS

A daily sheet will be handed out daily. The sheets will supply you with information regarding your child's day. This will include: lunch, nap, mood, and diaper changes.

TOYS

Please do not bring any toys to school. Children tend to be possessive over their own belongings causing conflict in the classroom.

IMMUNIZATIONS

Students MUST be up to date with their immunizations. It is the parent's responsibility to submit a copy of his/her updated immunizations of your child's first day of school and when they receive new vaccines.

FLU VACCINE

All students 6 months – 5 years old MUST receive the FLU vaccine every season (9/1-12/31). Those that do not get the vaccine will not be permitted to stay in school. Please remember to submit a copy of the immunization.
